## **PREVIOUS WORK**



A multi-sector network with a strong track record of collaborating with our 1,000+ member organisations, engaging with diverse communities across the city, and celebrating and disseminating information and learnings locally and nationally. Our recent activities include:

- Coordinating large scale gatherings in 2019 and 2020 to facilitate input into Bristol's One City Climate and Ecological Emergency Strategies.
- Engaging and convening over 200 expert stakeholders from across sectors to feed into Bristol's One City Plan and environment goals.
- Supporting and working with community partners and Black & Green Ambassadors to host community engagement events and creative workshops to inspire climate action, such as recent Black & Green conversations and craftivism workshops.
- Lead one of 19 projects funded from over 630 applications to the first round of the National Lottery's Climate Action Fund, to enable the innovative Community Climate Action project to go ahead with £2.5m successful bid.
- Coordinating city-wide action on food by a wide range of organisations, enabling Bristol to become only the second Gold Sustainable Food City in the UK.
- Facilitating several themed forums and providing secretariat support for the One City Environment Board and Bristol Advisory Committee on Climate Change.
- Lead a Climate Action Programme supporting businesses and organisations working towards net zero.

## Phase 2

- Creative communications programme to engage more and more diverse people in the climate conversation
